

**NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF BUDGET  
ESTIMATES AND TAX RATES**

Notice is hereby given the taxpayers of Jackson County, Town of Crothersville, Indiana, that the town council of Crothersville, Indiana, at 117 E. Howard Street on Tuesday, October 6, 2009 at 6:00 p.m., will conduct a public hearing on the Budget. Following this meeting, any ten or more taxpayers may object to a budget, tax rate, or tax levy by filing an objection petition with the proper officers of the political subdivision within seven days after the hearing. The objection petition must identify the provisions of the budget, tax rate or tax levy that taxpayers object to. If a petition is filed, the political subdivision shall adopt with its budget a finding concerning the objections filed and testimony presented. Following this aforementioned hearing, the Council will meet at Crothersville Town Hall, 117 E. Howard St., Crothersville on Tuesday, October 20, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. to adopt the following budget.
