

## PUBLIC NOTICE

On or about May 14, 2010 the Town of Crothersville intends to apply to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs for a grant from the Office of Community and Rural Affairs's CDBG Disaster Recovery Appropriation. This program is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. These funds are to be used for Community disaster assistance. The total amount of Disaster Recovery funds to be requested is \$1,428,908. The amount of Disaster Recovery funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit to low- and moderate-income persons is \$836,435. The Applicant also proposed to expend an estimated \$2,143,362 in non-CDBG funds on the project. These non-CDBG funds will be derived from the following sources: USDA - Rural Development Loan.

The Town of Crothersville will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, April 27, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. at the Crothersville Town Hall, 101 West Howard Street, Crothersville, Indiana to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally funded CDBG Disaster Recovery project. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

Interested citizens are invited to provide comments regarding these issues either at the public hearing or by prior written statement. Written comments should be submitted to the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer at the address listed below no later than April 26, 2010 in order to ensure placement of such comments in the official record of the public hearing proceedings. A plan to minimize displacement and provide assistance to those displaced has been prepared by the Town of Crothersville and is available to the public. This project will result in no displacement of any persons or businesses.
